REQUIREMENTS

THE PRESENCE OF THE APPLICANT IS MANDATORY

The Consular Registration Reissue application is to be submitted upon presentation of the following documents:

PLEASE NOTE: THE APPLICANT MUST PROVIDE THE ORIGINAL AND COPIES OF ALL DOCUMENTATION (ONE COPY FOR EACH DOCUMENT)

1. Old Consular Registration Card or Proof of loss.

2. Angolan Document – One of the following documents:

- Valid Passport.
- Valid Identity Card.

PLEASE NOTE, THE OLD IDENTITY CARDS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED EXCEPT THE LIFELONG ONES.

- Birth Certificate issued in Angola, endorsed by the *Direcção Nacional de Registos e Notariado (Ministério da Justiça e dos Direitos Humanos de Angola)* – i.e. National Directorate of Registries and Notaries (Ministry of Justice and Human Rights of Angola) and legalised by the *Ministério das Relações Exteriores de Angola (MIREX)* – i.e. Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Angola.

3. Proof of Occupation – Letter confirming employment or student status – On letterhead paper. If not in education, training or employment, please fill in the relevant form ([template](#)).

4. Proof of Address – One of the following documents:

- Water, Gas or Electricity Bill.
- Council Tax letter.
- UK Driving Licence.
- Bank Statement.

5. Proof of legal status in the United Kingdom – One of the following documents:

- Passport of one of the European Union countries.
- Permit of residence/stay in the United Kingdom.

FOR MINORS (under eighteen years old)

1) Old Consular Registration Card or Proof of loss.

2) Angolan Document of the Minor Applicant – One of the following documents:

- *Cédula Pessoal*.
- Valid Identity Card.
- Birth Certificate issued in Angola, endorsed by the *Direcção Nacional de Registos e Notariado (Ministério da Justiça e dos Direitos Humanos de Angola)* – i.e. National Directorate of Registries and Notaries (Ministry of Justice and Human Rights of Angola) and legalised by the *Ministério das Relações Exteriores de Angola (MIREX)* – i.e. Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Angola.

3) Angolan Document of one of the Parents or Legal Guardian – One of the following documents:

- Passport.
- Identity Card.

4) Consular Registration of one of the Parents or Legal Guardian.

5) Proof of Address of one of the Parents or Legal Guardian – One of the following documents:

- Water, Gas or Electricity Bill.

- Council Tax Letter.
- Child Tax Credit or Child Benefit Letter.
- UK Driving Licence.
- Bank Statement.

6) Proof of Legal Status in the United Kingdom of the Minor Applicant – One of the following documents:

- Passport of one of the European Union countries.
- Permit of residence/stay in the United Kingdom.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- The absence of any of the required documents may result in the application being denied.
- Whenever necessary, the Consulate General reserves the right to request the presentation of other documents or demand the presence of the applicant.
- The submitted documents will remain property of the Consulate General.

Reissue before expiry date: £5.00 (five pounds).

Reissue after expiry date: £8.00 (eight pounds).

Loss or damaged: £8.00 (eight pounds).

Correction of data due to applicant's error: £4.50 (four pounds and fifty pence).

Correction of data due to this Consulate's error: £0.00 (free).

Change of data: £9.00 (nine pounds).
