## MILITARY CENSUS

The Military Census is regulated by Law 1/93 of March 26 1993 - Military Service General Law (click here for details).

The legislation requires that Angolan male citizens are called to register and obliged to serve in the Angolan Armed Forces from the 1st January of the year they complete 20 years of age to the 31st December of the year they complete 45 years of age.

## **REQUIREMENTS**

#### THE PRESENCE OF THE APPLICANT IS MANDATORY

The Military Census registration is to be submitted upon presentation of the following documents:

PLEASE NOTE: THE APPLICANT MUST PROVIDE THE ORIGINAL AND COPIES OF ALL DOCUMENTATION (ONE COPY FOR EACH DOCUMENT)

- 1. One of the following Angolan Document:
  - Passport (pages 1, 2, 3 and 32)
  - Identity Card.
  - Birth Certificate.
- 2. Valid Consular Registration Card.
- 3. Certificate of Educational or Professional Qualifications.
- **4. Employment or School Acceptance Letter** On letterhead paper. If unemployed, please fill in the relevant form (template).

- 5. Two (2) Colour Passport Photographs, dated no more than three months previous, taken in front of a plain white background without sunglasses (except with proven medical exemption). Photos from male applicants must be taken without earrings, dreadlocks or Mohican (punk) hairstyles.
- **6. Proof of legal status in the United Kingdom** One of the following documents:
  - Passport of one of the European Union countries.
  - Permit of residence/stay in the United Kingdom.

### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

- The absence of any of the required documents may result in the application being denied.
- Whenever necessary, the Consulate General reserves the right to request the presentation of other documents or demand the presence of the applicant.
- The submitted documents will remain property of the Consulate General.
